



Student Athlete and Parent / Guardian Code of Conduct

Student participation in CCS sports and activities requires that each student athlete, his or her parent or guardian, and anyone else in his or her party, be a representation of Clovis Christian Schools at various venues. Representation will be done so appropriately, at all times, while at school, participating in practice, at home games or away games, and anywhere else that any individual is representing CCS in any form, whether it be interacting with, or as a, player, coach, fan or a parent / guardian. I understand that my student will be at every practice and game, ready to play. As parent or guardian, I, not CCS, will ensure that my child has transportation to and from every practice, game, and activity.

Conduct for every student athlete and parent / guardian is as follows:

- 1. To observe Biblical morality in all relationships and interactions, in word and deed, and to act with integrity and practice self-control at all times.
- 2. To approach the school and its programs and sports with a positive attitude and refrain from negativism in action, word or appearance.
- 3. To respond to all authority over them and to do so properly and respectively with an ear to listen, learn and obey.
- 4. To regard others with courtesy at all times. This includes, classmates, teammates, coaches, opposing players and parents, referees, schools, etc.

I understand that if myself, my student, or anyone in my party violates this Code of Conduct, that my student or myself may be dismissed from the team or facility temporarily, or permanently, from any current or future sports program.
